



Polished Concrete Maintenance

Adelaide Custom Concrete Machine Polished Concrete is a coating free system with the objective of providing a finished floor with little ongoing maintenance.

NB: The surface may initially have a slightly “waxy” appearance that will disappear after approximately 6 washes.

Adelaide Custom Concrete Polished Concrete although able to be walked on the next day, it should not be wet for 3 days.

The floor should be maintained on a regular basis by vacuuming and cleaning in the following manner:

To a bucket of warm water, add recommended amount of a (low ph cleaner) and mop floor with a microfibre mop. The floor should be damp for the shortest possible time. This will leave the floor clean and streak free. This simple cleaning should be carried out to keep the floor looking its best.

CAUTION: Concrete floors may be slippery, particularly when wet, please take care as no responsibility is accepted.

Do not use any buffing type machine or product other than specified as any type of abrasive cleaner will dull the surface.

Simple tips:

- Use a dry mop regularly.
- Avoid direct heat from free standing heaters.
- Spills should be cleaned up straight away to avoid penetration or damage
- At no point should a steam mop be used on your Machine Polished Floor.
- When washing your floor always leave the kitchen until last.
- Door mats recommend at all doors
